## **British Literature Questions**

- Medieval, Renaissance, and 17<sup>th</sup> Century: 50%
   Answer 2 of the 3 questions below. Each question is worth 25 points. Be sure to include an argumentative thesis and to use specific examples.
- 1. Chaucer's *General Prologue* provides an example of estates satire that give insight to the role of social class in medieval culture. Discuss how individual tales in *The Canterbury Tales* relate to the social position of the teller.
- 2. The sonnet form became extremely popular during the 1500s. Choose at least 3 authors of sonnets and discuss how they contributed to the development of the form.
- 3. After James I became King of England in 1603, new themes emerged in English drama. Choose at least 2 plays written during the Jacobean period and discuss the major themes they present.
- II. 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> Centuries: 50%

Answer 2 of the 3 questions below. Each question is worth 25 points. Be sure to include an argumentative thesis and to use specific examples.

- The Romantic Movement developed a new concept of the relationship between humans and Nature.
  Choose 3 poems from the Romantic Period and discuss how they illustrate the Romantic idea of
  Nature.
- 2. The development of the novel expanded the scope of women as writers. Choose at least 3 female authors and discuss how their novels reflect the experience of women in their society.
- 3. During the 20<sup>th</sup> century the relation of England to its colonies underwent enormous change. Choose 3 colonial authors and discuss how they contribute to the development of British literature.
