1. Define the following concepts related to morphology and give examples for
20% illustration: bound morpheme, inflectional morpheme, derivational morpheme, infix, circumfix. Among them, what concepts can be applied to the formation of "fanfuckin'tastic" in American English?
2. Provide four possible interpretations for the following sentence 'Time flies like
20% an arrow.' For each interpretation, invoke one relevant "thematic role" to account for the ambiguities involved.
3. Define the following three terms in phonology: minimal pair, phonemic
20% feature, and nasality, and use at least two examples of minimal pairs to determine whether nasality is a distinctive feature in English.
4. Define the two terms: language versus dialect. Give two phonological and two
20% syntactical features to show how AAVE (African American Vernacular English) is different from SAE (Standard American English). Give two lexical and two phonological features to show how SAE is different from BE (British English).
5. Define Wernicke's aphasia and Broca's aphasia and give at least three linguistic
20% performance features for each.
