Let's assume that you will be the leader of a book discussion. ( Any books will do. However, since all the participants speak English, you must write everything in English.)

1. Write a notice announcing the time, date, and place of the book discussion, and a brief introduction to the book so that people may get more attracted and prepared. 30% (Samples are given below.)
2. In addition, write a plan, in an essay form, for how you are going to lead the discussion. 70%  
You may want to take into consideration the variety of the participants, the length of the book discussion, the purpose of the book discussion, and the "tricks" facilitating responses.

Your writing will be graded according to creativity, organization, and expression.

December 11, 1997      *On Gold Mountain* by Lisa See

In the past century hundreds of thousands of Chinese immigrated to "Gold Mountain," the Chinese name for the United States, to seek their fortunes. See's chronicle melds together three generations of stories from her Chinese and American ancestors into a brilliant tapestry, interwoven with captivating tales that will enthrall readers of all backgrounds.
