- 1. "I saw torched bunkers, vehicles, shells from ammunition. It was truly unreal. The Iraqi soldiers were barely living from day to day on beans and rice. You could tell that they weren't expecting such an early ground war because they left their boots behind. You could also tell that an Allied tank not only shot at the bunker but ran right over the top of it. That is the price these soldiers had to pay. The thoughts that ran through me almost made me cry."
- 2. In recent years, brain-imaging technology has improved and the Internet has brought scattered research together. So scientists who study patients with Foreign Accent Syndrome have begun to understand the condition better. While brain researchers used to think language involved discrete regions of the brain, now they theorize that it involves a network of neurons crossing and connecting multiple regions. Foreign Accent Syndrome may involve a lesion somewhere along that network.
