How are these works related to their Greek and Roman precedents? What changes do British epic poets bring to the classical tradition? How does the British tradition end up in a reversal called "mock epic"?
- 2. What contributions did Mark Twain make to American literature? And why his true-to-life novels, such as *Adventures of Huckleberry Fin* and *Life on the Mississippi*, are NOT regarded as "pure" realist works?
- 3. Discuss at least two major features or writing techniques in "postmodern fiction."
