IV. Read the following article and then judge whether the statements below are true or false. Write T if the statement is true and F if the statement is false. 14%

What would you do if a drunk driver killed someone in your family? Candy Lightner had to answer that question in 1980 when a car ran into and killed her daughter. The driver of the car was not supposed to be on the road—he had had too much to drink, and he had a long record of arrests for drunk driving. Lightner was shocked by the accident. Then she learned that the driver might not go to jail. He would probably only lose his license for a while. Lightner couldn't believe it. Lightner thought that the law was supposed to protect innocent people, but losing the license for a short time was not a tough enough penalty to discourage drunk drivers. Lightner decided to start an organization called Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) to stop drunk drivers on the day of her daughter's funeral. Many of Lightner's friends thought she should just forget about it because they didn't believe an ordinary citizen like Lightner could change the laws. However, Lightner was persistent and determined. She was not going to give up. Finally, Candy Lightner and her organization had made a difference. Today if the police arrested you for drunk driving in any state in the US, you could lose your license for one year. And if it were your second offense, you could lose your license for up to two years. If you hurt or killed someone while drinking and driving, you would face a mandatory jail sentence.
