

Part A (每小題 2 分)

When you hear a statement, read the four sentences in your test and decide which one is closest in meaning to the statement you have heard. Then, on your answer sheet, find the number of the problem and choose your answers.

Listen to the following example:

You will hear:

You will read: (A) Consideration was given to all suggestions.

(B) Your idea is worth a considerable amount of money.

(C) That sounds like a pretty good idea.

(D) I'm not certain that I like your idea.

Sample Answer

A B C V D

Sentence (C), "That sounds like a pretty good idea," means most nearly the same as the statement "I certainly think the suggestion is worthy of consideration."

Therefore, you should choose answer (C).

You will read: (A) Ellen quit growing at Pamela's age.

(B) Pamela is short for her age.

(C) Pamela and Ellen are the same height.

(D) Ellen is older than Pamela.

Sample Answer

A B C D V

Sentence (D), "Ellen is older than Pamela," is closest in meaning to the sentence "Pamela is quite a bit taller than her sister Ellen was at her age."

Therefore, you should choose answer (D).
